## **ORDER**

In partial modification of this Office Order of even number dated 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 issued under Section 22 (2) (b) and Section 22 (2) (h) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, for preventing the spread of COVID-19, all the vehicles are hereby permitted to operate with up to 100% passenger capacity with immediate effect in the State subject to the following conditions:

- (a) In both private and commercial passenger vehicles, everyone including the Drivers, Attendants shall mandatorily wear mask at all times. No passenger shall be allowed to travel without **mask worn correctly.**
- (b) In no case, any vehicle shall carry more than the total seating capacity. There should not be any standing passenger in any vehicle.
- (c) All passenger vehicles shall mandatorily maintain a daily log book of all travelers with the following details: Name, Phone, and date of travel.
- (d) Hand sanitizer shall be carried at all times and all passengers must sanitize their hands before boarding.
- (e) The Driver/Attendant shall mandatorily carry appropriate disinfectants and periodically disinfect frequently touched surfaces of the vehicle such as doors and window handles, seats, overhead hand grips, etc.
- (f) The vehicles must be washed daily and disinfected periodically.
- (g) Drivers/attendants will not assemble or gather in groups at bus/taxi/auto rickshaw stands.
- (h) The Municipal/Town Council will ensure installation of adequate hand washing facilities- soap and running water or foot-operated alcohol-based Hand Sanitizer at the bus/taxi/auto rickshaw stand and display adequate IEC materials (posters/pamphlets/ flex banners).
- (i) The Municipal/Town Council in collaboration with concerned Union/Association of passenger vehicles will conduct orientation programme on standard preventive measure for Drivers and travelers. Necessary technical support will be provided by District Task Force.
- 2. In view of all the categories of passenger vehicles being now allowed to carry up to their maximum capacity, the RTAs/DTAs shall revisit the existing fares/rates and

consider revising them downwards suitably, if there were enhancements made earlier on grounds of restrictions on passenger capacity in the vehicles.
